

Travel Tips

Sri Lanka is 5½ hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time(GMT) During the winter months of December to January a light pullover might be required in the hills. During the hot summer months it is recommended that guests wear light natural fibres such as cotton or linen which is more comfortable, yet conservative attire. Guests should at all times travel with comfortable walking shoes and a wide-brimmed hat and drink plenty of bottled water.

Currency

The Rupee (LKR) is the currency of Sri Lanka, divided into 100 cents, all other major currencies and credit cards, (American Express, Visa, Master Card) are accepted. Foreign currency exchange is available at the resort.

Climate & Weather

Sri Lanka is tropical, with distinct dry and wet seasons. This is slightly complicated as there are two monsoons. The east welcomes the Maha monsoon from October to January, which brings rain and the dry season from May to September. From May to August the Yala monsoon brings rain to the island's southwestern half and dry season from December to March. There is an inter-monsoonal period in October and November when rain occurs across the island. Climatically speaking, the best tourist seasons in Sri Lanka are from April to September for the east coast and central regions and December to March for the west coast, the south coast and the Hill Country.

Average Temperature

The average annual temperature ranges from 28° to 32°C, with temperatures varying from a chilly low of 16°C in Nuwara Eliya, where frosting even occurs occasionally, whilst Trincomalee experiences highs upwards of 35°C in the northeast. Coastal areas are cooled by sea breezes year around.
